Wings

NOTE: lines for shortening or lengthening the wings as well as reducing or increasing their width are given on pattern pieces.. Adjust needed amount of tubing/tubing channel (indicated below) as necessary. Also, see note below for stitching wings*.

Double-sided fabrics:

45" No Nap: 4-1/4 for all sizes

Yardage for 45" goods does not allow for self-bias binding. 9 yards of 2-1/2" wide double-bias binding or single-bias binding are required for finishing.

54" No Nap: 3-5/8 for all sizes

Yardage for 54" goods allows for self-bias binding.

~7 yards 7/8" wide satin ribbon as tubing channels.

All other fabrics to be self-faced:

45" No Nap: 7-1/4 for all sizes

Yardage for 45" goods does not allow for self-bias binding. 9 yards of 2-1/2" wide double-bias binding or single-bias binding are required for finishing.

54" No Nap: 7-1/4 for all sizes

Yardage for 54" goods allows for self-bias binding.

****When stitching wings, be sure to use a stitch setting about 12 sts per inch to ensure the tubing inside will not show through the wing seams.***

~30 feet of 1/2" clear vinyl tubing (found in the plumbing section of many home improvement centers). Make sure to cut each piece continuously-do not make up length of tubing in a number of pieces per channel.

~1/2 yard of 1/2" elastic for wrist bands.

Crinoline

~ *EvaDress*s note: For the hoop skirt, I used and recommend View A and optional bustle pad View F of Laughing Moon's Hoops and Bustles #112 pattern from AgelessPatterns.com. It is a multi-size pattern.

~Steel:

To bone the corset, I use 1/4" or 1/2" spiral steel in lieu of genuine whalebones, but if you are so fortunate to have access to whalebones, then by all means!

If you desire, you may consider the total length in your corset size when reading the following bone length recommendations, as the following are prescribed for the size 10 corset:

4-1/2" bones each 14" long when tipped (these are for the back edges on each side of the line of eyelets).

29-1/2" bones at least 14" long to be cut to size and then tipped. If cutting and tipping the bones yourself, this requires a total of about 13 yards of boning and 58 tips of corresponding size.

You may optionally measure your pattern to determine desired bone lengths for your corset size in order to purchase pre-cut and tipped bones. When doing so, remember to calculate desired finished bone length to be 2" shorter than the total finished seam length where they will be placed (this is to ensure clearance under your sewing machine).

~11-1/2 yards of 1/2" boning channel tape.

~3 yards of 3/8" (9mm) double-side silk satin ribbon for lacing which you will cut for one 2 yard piece to lace from the top of the corset to the waistline and one 1 yard piece to lace the corset from the bottom to the waistline.

~22 to 24-#00 Eyelets (depending on corset size).

~18" invisible zipper (for optional side closure between left side forms 3 and 4).

~#3 hooks and eyes for fastening wings to corset.

21-pieces are given.
5/8" Seams are allowed unless otherwise noted on pattern
5/8" hem is allowed on skirt

This pattern fits 33" to 45" bust.

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
